Senior Female Bank Leaders to Discuss the Value of Inclusivity in the Workplace at Jersey Diversity Network Event

Inclusive leadership and the importance of creating an inclusive culture in the workplace are set to be the topics under the spotlight when two senior bank leaders take to the stage at this month's The Diversity Network (TDN) event in Jersey.

The breakfast event, which takes place at the Grand Jersey on 25th October 2018, will see Tracy Garrad, CEO, HSBC Channel Islands and Isle of Man and Sue Fox, CEO, M&S Bank, discuss their respective routes to CEO roles, what inclusive leadership means to them, and how they put this into action in the banks.
